DIAGNOSIS





GIANNECCHINI DIAGNOSIS

- 11/17/2012 – Went to hospital with shortness of breath. Pleural fluid showed malignant cells. Elevated CA125.
- 11/21/2012 – Hysterectomy performed. Stage III High Grade Serous Carcinoma

EXPOSURE





GIANNECCHINI EXPOSURE

- Daily usage from age 15-59 (> 16,000 applications)
- No prior hysterectomy
- No tubal ligation

RISK FACTORS





GIANNECCHINI RISK FACTORS

• Risk

- Obesity
- No breastfeeding

• Protective

- BRCA negative
- No endometriosis
- Non-smoker
- Age = 59
- 2 live births
- No family history
- No HRT
- Minimal birth control usage

Confirmed diagnosis

Extensive exposure

Minimal risk factors

Strong case for filing
